


STEP 1:

Firstly, place down a roll of tape or anything circular and draw around it with a pencil.




STEP 2:

Using a blending brush and a 'Pretty Color Inside' ink, in a circular motion, blend the colour within the shape you just drew.







STEP 3:

Get the two leaf stamps from the 'Instant Artist Reflection' stamp set and put them on seperate stamping blocks, add ink and stamp in multiple places on the card.




STEP 4:

Using a spray bottle, spray some water on your fingertips and then flick the water onto the card to create a watercolor effect.



STEP 5:

Next, select this stamp and use a Eureka, pressing down evenly to stamp.




STEP 6:

Lastly, choose the sentiment stamp 'you are wonderful', place it on the Eureka and press down to evenly stamp.







STEP 1:

Firstly, using a ripped up piece of card, some ink and and sponge daubber, ink above the ripped card and in a circular motion, ink a semi circle, adding more colors as you go.



STEP 2:

Using the leaf stamp from 'Instant Artist Reflection' stamp set, place on a stamping block, add ink and stamp in the corner of the card. Repeat this process for a shadow effect.









STEP 3:

Using a spray bottle, spray some water on your fingertips and then flick the water onto the card to create a watercolor effect. Once you have done this, lightly dab with a tissue to dry.



STEP 4:

Place the ripped piece of card back down, lining it up before using your Eureka and adding ink to this chosen stamp.



STEP 5:

Next, close the Eureka lid and press down evenly to stamp.




STEP 6:

Lastly, choose the sentiment stamp 'Love', place it on the Eureka and press down to evenly stamp.








STEP 1:

Firstly, using a range of ink colors, in a back and forth motion, ink the colors in a row down the card.




STEP 2:

Then using a spray bottle, spray water directly on the card where the ink is to let it bleed out. After doing this, to dry the ink, use a heat gun.







STEP 3:

To blend some colour together more, use a sponge daubber and lightly dab the ink.



STEP 4:

Next, choose this skyline stamp, line up using a Eureka, close the lid and press down evenly to stamp.



STEP 5:

Lastly, choose the sentiment stamp 'Let it rain', place it on the Eureka and press down to evenly stamp.








STEP 1:

Firstly, cut out a semi circle and place it on the card to use as a mask. Then, place down a ripped piece of card below. Use a blending brush and 'Pretty Color Inside' ink to blend the color from the edge of your positioned paper.



STEP 2:

Using the same piece of ripped card, turn your card upside down and repeat this process with a different color.








STEP 3:

Remove the pieces of card and then using a blending brush, blend the ink inwards to remove harsh lines.



STEP 4:

Next, choose this skyline stamp, line up using a Eureka, ink the stamp, close the lid and press down evenly to stamp.



STEP 5:

Using a spray bottle, spray some water on your fingertips and flick the water onto the card directly on the ink. Also, then go in with a white gel pen, drawing into the stamp to add light.



STEP 6:

Lastly, choose the sentiment stamp 'Explore. Dream. Discover.', place it on the Eureka and press down to evenly stamp.








STEP 1:

Using the 'Pretty Color Inside' inks, start swiping down from the top of the card to create this effect. Multiple colors can be used.



STEP 2:

Using the same piece of ripped card, turn your card upside down and repeat this process with a different color.








STEP 3:

Choose the couple stamp, position on a Eureka and ink the stamp up. Once done, using a tissue, remove the ink from the umbrellas only. Then close the lid and press down to evenly stamp. After completing this, using a different color ink, ink the umbrellas by using a sponge daubber and proceed to stamp angain.



STEP 4:

Then using the leaf stamp, place onto a stamping block, ink the stamp and then proceed to stamp around the card for a foliage effect.



STEP 5:

Using a spray bottle, spray some water on your fingertips and then flick the water directly on the card to create a watercolor effect.



STEP 6:

Lastly, choose the sentiment stamp 'You are wonderful', place it on the Eureka and press down to evenly stamp.
